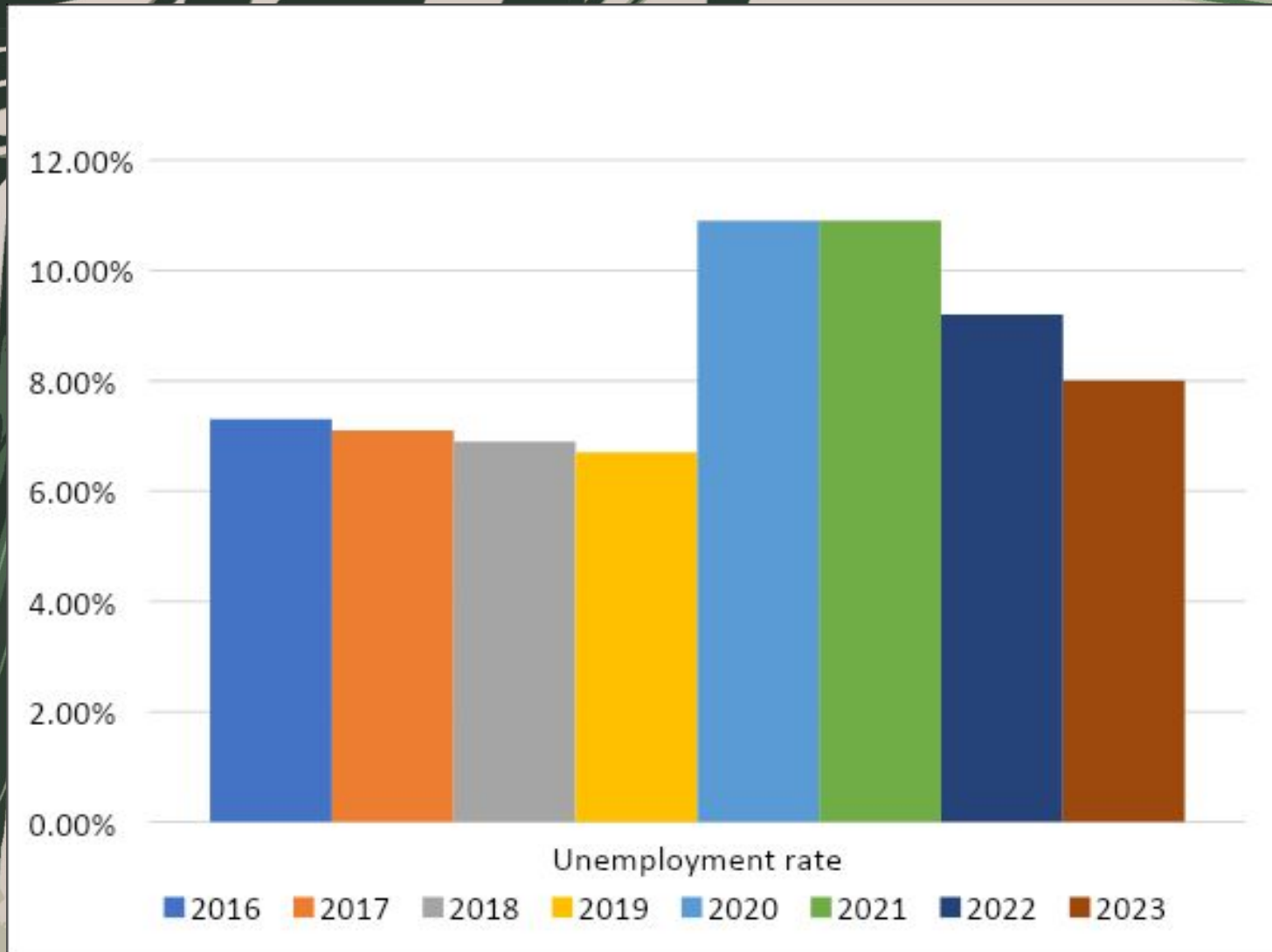

Unemployment Rate Evolution

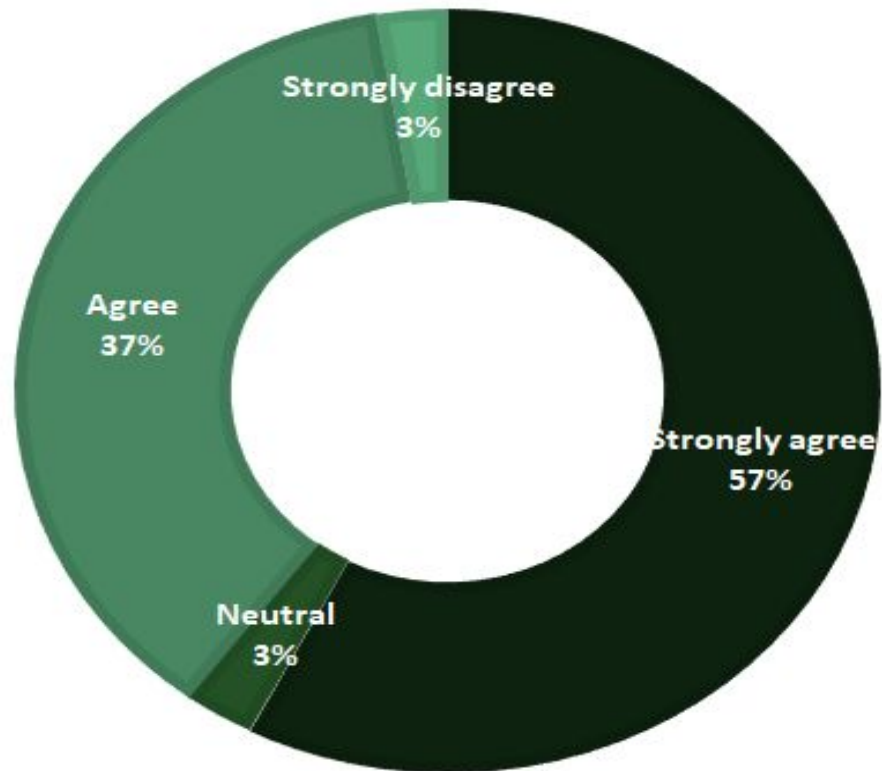




Survey Result on Unemployment and mental health
