




So, what did we observe?


Due to health concerns and other factors, around 22% of the population* is unable to enjoy the outstanding natural landscapes that Mauritius has to offer.






What are the barriers that prevent people from going into the different natural hotspots present on the island namely Nature reserves, mountains and botanical gardens. (You may choose one or more)




What is your main interest wherever you go the different natural hotspots (Nature reserves, mountains and botanical gardens) present in Mauritius?




Do you think merging technology to view different aspects of our surrounding environment will help citizens in the community?




Do you think a community-based project with the aim to Bring nature closer to people through technological means will be beneficial to both the community and the people living in it?








To what extent do you agree with the following: Visualising 360 degree videos with its natural sound can contribute to making people experience our natural environment?






To what extent do you agree to the following: Visualising 360 degree videos of the different natural hotspots in Mauritius can help people who have disabilities to attend those places?




To what extent do you agree with the following statement: Visualising a 360 degree video through a virtual reality headset can contribute to the peacefulness of the mind?






MATERIAL USED: GOPRO MAX 360, A DRONE AND A LAPTOP FOR EDITING




Presentation of the project to the community







Photos et vidéos : ces plateformes pour visiter l'île Maurice devant son écran

« Bringing nature closer to you »




« Bringing nature closer to you » est le projet de cinq jeunes mauriciens réunis sous le nom de SmartHands. Ils ont débuté leur collaboration dans le cadre d'un programme organisé par le National Productivity and Competitiveness Council (NPCC). Le National Leadership Engine a pour objectif de développer des projets innovants et utiles pour la société. Sur leur plateforme, on retrouve des vidéos à 360 degrés et en résolution 5,6 K, ainsi que des photos. Elles sont visibles notamment via une application pour téléphone mobile. SmartHands propose également de fabriquer soi-même un casque de réalité virtuelle (VR) avec du carton et un smartphone. Avec cet outil, les utilisateurs peuvent contempler les vidéos à 360 degrés.

« Les membres de notre équipe dévouée ont utilisé leur créativité pour que des objets soient créés avec des déchets. Cette idée est une approche innovante à Maurice. Nous pouvons capturer à la fois des images et du son grâce à notre caméra spécialisée. Notre objectif est de filmer plusieurs beaux paysages comme les montagnes, les cascades, les parcs naturels et les réserves naturelles, entre autres, auxquels les gens ne peuvent normalement pas accéder », explique Dominique Baho, team leader de SmartHands dans une correspondance au Défi Plus.

SmartHands pense notamment aux utilisateurs qui ne peuvent pas se promener à cause de leurs problèmes de santé ou à ceux qui cherchent de nouveaux lieux à visiter. « Nous pensons que cette innovation peut donner aux utilisateurs un meilleur état d'esprit et les conscientiser à la protection de la nature à travers des vidéos à 360 degrés. Nous avons choisi le nom SmartHands, car nous pensons tous qu'apporter une solution innovante utilisant la technologie peut façonner un meilleur avenir. Pour réaliser ce que nous désirons, il faut travailler main dans la main. Ce n'est qu'ainsi que nous pouvons accomplir beaucoup pour notre société et améliorer la vie des gens », commente Dominique Baho.

«Smart Hands For Nature»: des randonnées virtuelles de sites difficiles d'accès



«Smart Hands for Nature» fait vivre une expérience immersive à ceux qui ne peuvent accéder à certains sites.

Les Sept cascades, l'Île Ronde, l'Île-aux-Aigrettes, Ebony Forest, la montagne du Morne Brabant, autant de reliefs arpentés par des randonneurs aguerris, mais souvent inaccessibles pour les marcheurs du dimanche ou ceux qui aiment le farniente. *Smart Hands for Nature* vous transporte aux quatre coins de l'île pour découvrir ces sentiers, ces chutes d'eau, ces plantes endémiques et ces espèces protégées. Les pentes, les cours d'eau et les chemins inaccessibles ne font pas peur à ces jeunes, qui veulent offrir une incursion naturelle à travers un écran tactile.

Dominique Baho, biologiste et chef du projet *Smart Hands For Nature*, souligne que la randonnée est une activité très prisée des Mauriciens. «Sauf que tous les sites ne sont pas accessibles aux amateurs de sorties. C'est de là que l'idée a émergé. Rendre accessible ce qui est inaccessible et, par ricochet, faire grandir notre communauté de randonneurs. C'est notre mission. Nous voulons offrir des images en 360 degrés et des photos de qualité supérieure pour ceux qui ne peuvent se rendre dans ces lieux inédits, toujours protégés du développement.»

Dominique Baho explique que c'est lors du *National Leadership Engine*, une formation du *National Productivity and Competitiveness Council* (NPCC), qu'il a rencontré d'autres jeunes, qui voulaient découvrir la nature, mais ne savaient pas comment faire. *«Nous sommes cinq personnes, dont certaines n'ont jamais fait de la randonnée. Pour démarrer notre aventure commune, nous avons donc organisé des sorties sur des sites accessibles. <i>Notre mission est de rapprocher les Mauriciens de leur île avec ces lieux méconnus mais fréquentés par les randonneurs. C'est un moyen de montrer la beauté et la richesse de notre pays»*, a souligné le jeune biologiste.

Personnes âgées, handicapées...

L'application mobile permettra aux personnes âgées, handicapées, aux touristes et aux Mauriciens de visiter plusieurs lieux à travers leur smartphone. «L'application mobile est à multiples dimensions, soit pour l'éducation des enfants, pour rapprocher les Mauriciens de la nature, pour la sensibilisation à sa protection et aussi pour promouvoir l'écotourisme», a fait ressortir Dominique Baho, qui nous montre les vidéos tournées dans les lieux de randonnées. L'application mobile sera lancée lundi prochain par Smart Hands for Nature.

Comment sont choisis les sites pour la randonnée virtuelle? À cette question, notre interlocuteur parle des lieux qu'il a lui-même visités. «Étant biologiste, j'ai eu l'occasion de visiter pas mal de lieux, comme l'Île Ronde où très peu de personnes se rendent. J'ai fait des shootings photos et des vidéos. Alors que pour les autres sites de randonnée, je dois voir si le parcours est accessible à mon équipe. Au cas contraire, je vais sur le terrain ou je me fais accompagner par des habitués. Les prises de vues sont faites avec des sons de la nature pour rendre l'expérience plus réelle», raconte le biologiste.

Ce projet vise à attirer des touristes, des investisseurs et des chercheurs. «Nous avons une flore et une faune uniques. De nombreux étrangers viennent en stages d'études ou pour découvrir cette partie de Maurice.»

Fonds marins

Dans l'offre de *Smart Hands for Nature*, il y a aussi un volet concernant l'exploration des fonds marins de Maurice. Ce groupe de jeunes veut s'atteler à un projet d'envergure, à savoir, recycler des déchets pour créer des casques immersifs de réalité virtuelle.

Basé sur les *Virtual Reality cardboard*, il suffira de placer son smartphone au bout du casque pour accéder à cet univers naturel grâce aux images et à la vidéo de *Smart Hands for Nature*. Être en contact avec la nature ne sera alors plus qu'à quelques clics.
